Artemis Pentland Peaks Challenge

EVENT REGULATIONS

The Artemis Pentland Peaks Challenge is sponsored by the Artemis Charitable Foundation (a charitable trust registered in Scotland, number SC037857) of 6th Floor, Exchange Plaza, 50 Lothian Road, Edinburgh, Scotland, EH3 9BY. WildFox Events Limited has been employed to create and manage the event on their behalf. By registering to take part in the Artemis Pentland Peaks Challenge you are agreeing to the following conditions of entry and any instructions given to you by the organisers, officials and marshals before, during or after the event. This includes complying with the law and any government guidelines and taking steps to protect yourself and all others present from the risk of infection.

- You must be at least 18 years of age on Saturday 2nd September 2023. If you are 16 or 17 you can take part if accompanied by an adult throughout the route.
- You will pay the Artemis Charitable Foundation a registration fee of £50 per person via our third party registrations company Active. Your place is not secured until your fee is received.
- Places will be limited and if the Artemis Pentland Peaks Challenge becomes oversubscribed due to changes in ongoing restrictions then places would be allocated on a first come first served basis. Latecomers would be put on a waiting list and contacted should any places become available prior to event day. They will also be given the option to defer their place to 2024.
- Should government guidelines prevent us from running the event at all for any reason WildFox Events Ltd will defer your entry to 2024.
- The registration fee is non-refundable however any registration query will be answered on a case by case basis. If you wish to discuss your registration you should do this in writing to info@wildfoxevents.com and any request to alter your registration (for instance swapping your place with a friend) should be made no later than 18th August 2023 and we reserve the right to request some written verification such as a doctor's note stating that you are medically certified as unfit to participate. WFE will deduct a £10 admin charge for such amendments.
- If WildFox Events have no option but to defer your entry to 2024 we will do so for no additional charge however if the deferral is at your written request and you contact us prior to 18th August then there is a WildFox Events Ltd administration charge of £10 per place that we carry over to 2024. Registration fees can only be deferred for one year. A rolled-over registration fee does not guarantee entry in 2024; it is the sole responsibility of the participant to confirm they wish to take up the place.
- The Artemis Pentland Peaks Challenge is a fundraising event and in 2023 it will be supporting the work of Mary's Meals and The John Muir Trust. We will be in touch after you've registered to tell you more about the work that they do and by registering for this event you give us permission to send you such information and to encourage you to support Mary's Meals and the John Muir Trust. Each participant is expected to raise at least £250 for these nominated charities, and we will give you more details of how to fundraise and donate. If for any reason you choose not to take up your place or the event is cancelled or postponed, or you are not permitted to take part in the event, all sponsorship forms and money collected for Mary's Meals and The John Muir Trust must be forwarded to them and will not be refunded.
- You are responsible for ensuring that you have the appropriate level of fitness to participate in the Artemis Pentland Peaks Challenge. You are strongly advised to consult a doctor before undertaking any strenuous exercise or training programme, or participating in the event. If any government regulations require participants in such events to take measures to minimise the risk of infection you agree to act according to the rules at that time or forfeit your place in the event.
- You are taking part in the Artemis Pentland Peaks Challenge at your own risk. The sponsor Artemis Charitable Foundation and the organisers WildFox Events Ltd or anyone working or acting on their behalfs will have no responsibility for any risk, loss or costs that you incur in connection with the event and you will indemnify the sponsors, organisers and any persons acting on their behalf for any risk, damages, loss or costs arising as a result of your registration and your participation in the event. The sponsors and organisers will not carry insurance in relation to your personal participation in the event so it is your responsibility to obtain any necessary insurance in connection with the Artemis Pentland Peaks Challenge. You may wish to consider obtaining cancellation insurance as the registration fee is non-refundable.
- Prior to and during the event you will be responsible for your own safety, you will take all reasonable care to ensure the safety of other participants and you will comply promptly with all instructions and guidelines given by the Scottish Government, by the organisers, and any persons acting on their behalf. There will be marshals located on the route and all volunteers and staff involved in the event will be clearly identifiable.

EVENT REGULATIONS

Artemis Pentland Peaks Challenge

- All participants will be given an event identifier at registration, which must be displayed for identification at checkpoints and is your passport to refreshments.
- You must check in at each checkpoint and details of the system to be used will be given to you prior to the event. If you retire from the event you must inform the marshals at that checkpoint or call Event Control if you are retiring between checkpoints. You must also ensure that you return any timing wristband or equivalent equipment to a marshal. Participants who do not return such equipment will be charged for its replacement.
- The Artemis Pentland Peaks Challenge is subject to cut-offs. Entrants should take note of the cut-off times on the day of the event. They are non-negotiable. These cut-off times may be subject to change for the safety of both participants and volunteers.
- You agree to be suitably equipped to take part in the event and we reserve the right to remove you from the event should you not be adequately equipped. Please refer to the website for the compulsory kit list
- The organisers reserve the right to terminate an individual's participation on health and safety grounds.
- The Artemis Pentland Peaks Challenge will only be cancelled, re-routed or stopped on the day if advised to do so by our hill safety team for reasons of safety such as extreme weather conditions or if government regulations require WildFox Events Ltd to do so.
- Any last minute amendments to the event, including a last minute cancellation will be made entirely at the discretion of the organisers WildFox Events. Any such decision would be as a last resort when all other options have been ruled out. If the event is prevented from taking place or must out of necessity be changed - eg the route altered - then the Entry fee and any costs incurred by participants will not be refundable at that point.
- Photos taken during the event by our official photographer or other staff member may be used in the Artemis Pentland Peaks Challenge marketing promotions. Drones are not allowed at all.
- Privacy: We, the sponsors and organisers of the Artemis Pentland Peaks Challenge respect your privacy and we are committed to protecting your personal data. During the registration process we collect data, use, store and transfer different kinds of personal data about you which we have grouped together follows:
 - Identity Data includes first name, last name, date of birth and gender.
 - Contact Data includes contact address, email address, and telephone numbers

We (WildFox Events) will only use your personal data in relation to the event. We will use your personal data in the following circumstances:

- Where we need to perform the contract we are about to enter into or have entered into with you.
- Where it is necessary for our legitimate interests (or those of a third party) by which we mean the interest of our business (the effective operation of the Artemis Pentland Peaks Challenge) in conducting and managing our business to enable us to give you the best service.
